## Important Notes

### Non-English Language Proficiency

- a. The minimum level of proficiency which the selected students must have at the time of application is a level just lower than the requirement specified, if there are any. (e.g. if intermediate level is required, students must have elementary level at the time of application, i.e. about 150-200 learning hours or currently enrolled in a Language IV course at CUHK.) By the time the students participate in the exchange programmes, they should fulfill the specified requirement.
