

Global Learning Award Scheme

Handling of \$10,000 Exchange Scholarship Recipients' Applications

For students who are entitled to \$10,000 exchange scholarship when admitted to College, they can redeem the scholarship by applying for the Global Learning Award Scheme.

Similarity with other applicants

- Similar as other applicants, students entitled to the \$10,000 exchange scholarship also need to submit their application forms before the deadline of the corresponding round. Late application will not be accepted in general.
- In the application form, these students also need to upload supporting document (admission letter / result confirmation email) to show that they are participating in an overseas learning programme if it is not self-initiated.
- After finishing the programme, these students must also fulfill all post-programme submission requirements in order to receive the award amount. For more details, please refer to the "GLAS post-programme submission guideline" file.

Difference with other applicants

- Different from other applicants, students entitled to the \$10,000 exchange scholarship do not need to attend interview.
- These students would be guaranteed of receiving \$10,000 regardless of the budget / actual cost.
- These students' proposals could be simpler. They just need to include programme name, period, venue & a brief summary of the programme content.

Special Remarks

For students who could be awarded more than \$10,000 according to GLAS calculation mechanism, they could choose to attend the interview **AND** submit **DETAILED proposals just like other applicants**. The Committee will further assess their applications and decide if they could be granted more than \$10,000. However, they would be guaranteed of at least \$10,000 no matter they attend the interview or not.
